WHĀKAPIRIA TE PAKI KI TE KĀPIA

WHRAPPIRA TE PKI KI TE KAPIA

HE WHĀNAU TĀTOU

- ▶ Hangaia he huinga kāri kararehe e.g., 4 x kāri kau, 4 x kāri kurī, 4 x kāri hipi ...
 - ▶ Riwhirirwhia, ka toha ai i tētahi ki ia ākonga.
 - ▶ Me moe ngā karu o ngā ākonga, ka hikoi haere ai me te whakaputua i te tangi kararehe e tika ana ki te kimi i tōna whānau (me noho wātea te rūma).
 - ▶ Ina kitea, ka noho tahi, ka tuku pātai mō ō rātou tuakiri (ō rātou ingoa, iwi, ngā mea pai ki a rātou, ...).
 - ▶ Ka riro mā ia ākonga e whakaatu ngā kōrero mō tētahi atu o tōna whānau ki te rōpū nui.

WHRARRPIRA TE PRHI HI TE KAPPIA

- ▶ Ka tū ngā ākonga ki waenga o te akomanga.
 - ▶ Karangahia atu ētahi “kōwhiri-rua”, pērā i: “te ika ki tēnei taha, te mīti ki tēnei taha”.
 - ▶ Ka rere ngā ākonga ki te mea e pai ake ana ki a rātou.
 - ▶ Kia hāngai ngā kōwhiri-rua ki ë ãkonga, pērā i te: Pukamata/Paeāhua, hïkoi/oma, ārani/panana.
 - ▶ He wā anō ka tū, ã, ka matapaki ngā ākonga i ã rātou kōwhiringa.

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РОНО, РОНО, ТЕКА

- ▶ I ngā rōpū iti, ka whakaputa ia ākonga i ētahi kōrero mōna; e rua me pono, kotahi me teka.
 - ▶ Mā ērā atu e whiriwhiri ko tēhea te kōrero teka.
 - ▶ Me kawe i runga i te wairua manaaki.

- ▶ **Ka mau te pōro, ka rere te kōrero**
- ▶ **Ka tū porohita ngā ākonga, me te whiu haere i te pōro i waenganui i a īātou.**
- ▶ **Kia mau te pōro i īētahi, me whakaputa ia i tētahi kōrero mōna. Tonua he kaupapa, pērā i te īingoa o te īēkonga, kupu hei whakaahula ī ia ia, tana tino pukepuka, tino pūmanawa/ īngokorefāngā.**
- ▶ **Metea peea te pōro ki te katoa i roto i īētahi wa ka tohua.**

WHAKAPIRIA TE RAKI KI TE KĀPIA

WHAREWHARE ĀHUA TANGATA

- Tautohua kia 25 ngā kōrero mō te tangata, pēnei i ēnei: he aroha nui ki te kuri; he pai ake ki a ia te oma i te kauhoe; kua tae ki tāwahī ...
 - Tuhia kia kotahi ki ia pukurau o te tutukutuku 5x5.
 - Hoatu he kape o te tutukutuku ki ia ākonga.
 - Me kimi ko wai ngā ākonga e hāngai ana aua kōrero ki a rātou, ka tuhi ai i te ingoa tika ki ia pukurau.
 - Ko te ākonga tuatahi ka kapi tana tutukutuku, ka karanga ake 'WHAREWHARE!'

WHRHHPHIRH LE PHRI RI LE RHPH

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PANE RONGONU

- Tuia ngā ingoa o ētahi tāngata rongonui ki ngā pepa hāpiapia.
- Whakapiria tētahi ki te tuarā o tēnā, o tēnā ākonga.
- Ka tukua e te ākonga he pātai “āe”, “kāo” rānei – kia kotahī noa ki tēnā, ki tēnā o te rōpū – kīte kimi ko wai ia.
- Ko te ākonga tuatahi ka mohio ko wai ia, kīte kīte a te ākonga.



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PEOPLE BINGO

- ▶ Identify 25 characteristics, e.g., loves dogs, prefers water to juice, has been overseas ...
- ▶ Write one characteristic in each cell of a 5x5 grid.
- ▶ Give a copy of the grid to each student.
- ▶ Students 'find' people who match the characteristics – writing the person's name in the appropriate cell.
- ▶ The first student to fill ALL cells, calls 'BINGO!'

TRUTH, TRUTH, LIE

- ▶ In small groups, students take turns to tell one lie and two truths about themselves.
- ▶ The group guesses which statement was a lie.
- ▶ Ensure students are respectful of one another.

YOU CHOOSE

- ▶ Students stand in the middle of a hall or classroom area.
- ▶ Call out a set of choices e.g., "Fish or meat", pointing to opposite sides of the room for each option.
- ▶ Students go to the side of their preference.
- ▶ Make choices relevant to your students, e.g., Facebook or Instagram; walk or run; orange or banana.
- ▶ Stop (periodically) and get students to discuss the choice they made.

BALL GAME

- ▶ Standing in a circle, students throw a ball to each other.
- ▶ The "catcher" says one thing about themselves. Select a relevant topic e.g., their full name, a word to describe themselves, a favourite book, biggest strength/weakness.
- ▶ Try setting a time limit for the ball to get to everyone.

CeleBRITY HEADS

- ▶ Write the names of celebrities on post-it notes.
- ▶ Stick a post-it on the back of each student.
- ▶ Students ask each other "yes" or "no" questions to identify who they are – e.g., "I only have one eye".
- ▶ The first person to guess correctly wins.

WE ARE FAMILY

- ▶ Create sets of animal cards e.g., 4 cow cards, 4 dog cards, 4 sheep cards ...
- ▶ Mix, and give one to each student.
- ▶ Students close their eyes, and walk around 'calling' out to each other to find their 'family' (ensure there are no obstacles in the way).
- ▶ Once found, they sit together and ask questions about each other e.g., full name, iwi, likes etc.
- ▶ Students introduce each other to the wider group.



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
